Hall Tavern Farm

Hall Tavern Farm is owned and managed by Jay Healy, former State Representative and Department of Agricultural Resources Commissioner. The 500-acre property has been in his family for more than 100 years. A certified Tree Farm, Hall Tavern Farm upholds the values of sustainable forest management for clean water, recreation, wildlife habitat, and timber. Hall Tavern Farm has twice been named the MA Tree Farm of the Year.

Hall Tavern Farm is a sustainable choice for high quality, locally harvested Eastern White Pine, Hemlock, Oak, Ash, and Cherry. A kiln dries the wood, fueled by the wood waste from the mill. Sophisticated controls on the kiln allow Mr. Healy to control the drying process to prevent warping of the wood.

A wood boiler, also fueled with waste wood from the mill, heats the house. An array of solar panels meets 85% of electricity demand, so Hall Tavern Farm is practically off the grid.

A diverse and resilient enterprise, Hall Tavern Farm also produces hay, maple syrup, vegetables, and firewood.
