
Meet A Landowner

Rich and Debbie are high school sweethearts from the Sturbridge Area who have built their dream home in Warren.




Deer Meadow Farm has 66 acres of land in the Chapter 61/61A program. The Julian family sells the hay from their fields and manages their woodlands.
